Keeping Safe and Stopping the spread of COVID-19

The below table summarises the hierarchical principles for the controlling the risk of exposure of operatives to COVID-19 whilst travelling in a vehicle. In order to minimise the risk to health and in order to operate within Social Distancing Guidelines the following controls must be applied for all travel in vehicles. You must apply the highest level of control that is reasonably practicable.

Travel Hierarchy of Control

If you are experiencing a new / persistent cough and / or High temperature you should not be travelling, you must inform your supervisor and self-isolate

You should not travel with anyone presenting the symptoms above! All vehicles must be kept clean and disinfected before and after use


Eliminate

Travel Alone in vehicle



Minimise

Where travel alone cannot be achieved, maximum possible distancing between the driver and passenger must be maintained as followed:





Mitigate

Where distancing guidance cannot be achieved e.g

This should be raised immediately with your Supervisor and, where possible additional controls will be implemented



Additional controls may include:

- · Review of travel arrangements
- Review of maximum achievable distancing
- Provision of face masks (Where available)
- Provision of disposable gloves
